

**INFORMATION REGARDING TRIALS, HEARINGS AND CONFERENCES
DURING THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY CAUSED BY COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)**

Given the concerns surrounding COVID-19 (Coronavirus) and the Governor's declaration of a public health emergency, effective immediately, Judge Humphrey will be conducting all non-evidentiary trials, hearings and conferences by phone. He will decide on a case by case basis whether an evidentiary trial or hearing can proceed telephonically or whether the matter will be continued. With that in mind, during the next 30-day period, all non-evidentiary matters will be moved to the phone and the court will contact counsel with the conference call information. This period may be extended as the situation develops. If any matter requires an evidentiary presentation and there is no urgency, a 30-day continuance will be approved. If all parties have consulted and believe that a matter needs to proceed immediately, please contact Judge Humphrey's Courtroom Deputy, Joni Behnken, by email at joni_behnken@ohsb.uscourts.gov or by phone at (937) 225-2863 and Judge Humphrey will determine how to proceed. Email contact is preferred.

If you need to request an accommodation for a meeting of creditors, please contact the trustee.
