GENERAL ORDER NO. 60-1


On January 31, 2024, the Honorable C. Kathryn Preston will retire as a United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Southern District of Ohio. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §154(b), which authorizes the Chief Judge to ensure that the business of the Bankruptcy Court is handled expeditiously and efficiently, the Clerk is directed to rebalance the caseloads of the Columbus Bankruptcy Judges through the following reassignment of cases on December 15-17, 2023, unless precluded by judicial conflicts.

Chapter 7 and chapter 12 cases currently assigned to Judge Preston shall be reassigned to either the Honorable John E. Hoffman, Jr., or the Honorable Mina Nami Khorrami. Chapter 13 cases currently assigned to Judge Preston shall be reassigned to Judge Nami Khorrami. Chapter 13 cases currently assigned to Judge Nami Khorrami, which are administered by Trustee Faye English, shall be reassigned to Chief Judge Hoffman.
