ADOPTING INTERIM BANKRUPTCY
RULE 1007-I AND AMENDMENT TO
OFFICIAL FORM 22A**

Whereas the Judicial Conference of the United States approved transmitting Interim Rule 1007-I and the Amendment to Official Form 22A to the courts with a recommendation that they be adopted through a local rule or standing order to take effect on December 19, 2008; and

Whereas the recommended effective date of the Interim Rule and the Amendment to Official Form 22A does not provide sufficient time to promulgate rules after appropriate public notice and an opportunity for comment;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2071, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the proposed Interim Rule 1007-I and the Amendment to Official Form 22A are adopted in their entirety without change by a majority of the judges of this Court to be effective December 19, 2008.¹ Interim Rule 1007-I and Official Form 22A shall remain in effect, as may be amended from time to time, until further order of this Court.

¹ Interim Rule 1007-I incorporates provisions of Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007(c). Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007(c) was amended on December 1, 2012 to eliminate the existing time for filing the list of creditors in an involuntary case. This Amended General Order Number Nine is entered to adopt the amendment to Interim Rule 1007-I effective as of December 1, 2012 and to clarify that any future amendments to Interim Rule 1007-I and corresponding amendments to Official Form 22A are likewise adopted by this Court pursuant to this Amended General Order Number Nine.
