GENERAL ORDER: United States
Bankruptcy Court, Southern District
of Ohio (Cincinnati, Columbus, and
Dayton) **Effective** April 18, 2013

The Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure ("Rules") require the clerk "or some other person as the court may direct" to provide certain notices. Pursuant to this Court's authority to delegate noticing responsibilities under the following Rules, the following notices shall be provided by the following parties (in lieu of the clerk):

Notice of Chapter 7 Final Report Summary	Chapter 7 Trustee	2002(f)(8)
Notice of Continued Confirmation Hearing in Chapter 13 Case	Party Requesting Continuance	2002(b)

This order may be amended, from time to time, to include additional notices or remove notices addressed by amendment to the local rules.
