ORDER VACATING CERTAIN PREVIOUSLY ISSUED GENERAL ORDERS BASED ON REVISION OF LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES

(Effective October 1, 2020)

- 7. General Order # 29-1 Abrogating Local Bankruptcy Rule 4001-1(a)(8)
