GENERAL ORDER NO. 51-1
(Effective July 1, 2021)

On May 18, 2021, the Court entered General Order 41-3 (Revised Temporary Filing Procedures), reopening the Court's intake desks for limited hours of operation. Given the continuing decline of COVID-19 cases in the Southern District of Ohio since the beginning of 2021 and access to vaccination for all Ohio adults since March 29, 2021, it is hereby ORDERED:

1) General Order 41-3 is **VACATED** and its temporary filing procedures are **ABROGATED**, reopening the intake desks for normal hours of operation between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

2) The Clerk's Office will continue to maintain drop boxes in the lobby of each courthouse as long as the Clerk sees fit; provided, however, that the Clerk's Office shall issue a public notice if drop boxes are removed or subsequently reinstated.

This Order is effective July 1, 2021.
