GENERAL ORDER NO. 53-1  
(Effective November 8, 2021)


Effective immediately, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Ohio will adopt the following procedure regarding the refund of filing fees:

- (a) General Rule. Filing fees shall not be refunded, unless the court orders otherwise due to extenuating circumstances, or the fees were collected without authority, or due to an administrative error on the part of the Clerk. Refunds generally will not be permitted if a party files a document in error, even if the court dismisses the case or proceeding or denies the relief requested.
- (b) Requests for Refund. All requests for the refund of the payment of fees shall be initiated by filing a written motion and shall comply with LBR 9013-1. If granted, refunds will be processed through the electronic credit card system, or as otherwise determined by the Clerk. Repeated refund requests may result in an order to show cause why further requests for refunds should be considered.
