ORDER VACATING CERTAIN
PANDEMIC PROCEDURES

GENERAL ORDER NO. 54-1

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recently updated its framework to monitor the level of COVID-19 in communities. Most of the United States population is now in a location with a low or medium community level. This includes Franklin, Hamilton, and Montgomery counties. Consequently, the following general orders are no longer necessary and are hereby **VACATED**:

- General Order 47-1 (Order Regarding Courthouse Entry Requirements);
- General Order 35-9 (Order Regarding Matters Scheduled Before the Court Beginning August 2, 2021);
- General Order 40-1 (Order Extending Deadline for Completion of Financial Management Certification); and
- General Order 42-1 (Temporary Supplemental Procedures for Suspension of Chapter 13 Plan Payments).

Until further notice, courthouse visitors shall abide by CDC guidelines with respect to courthouse entry and face coverings.
