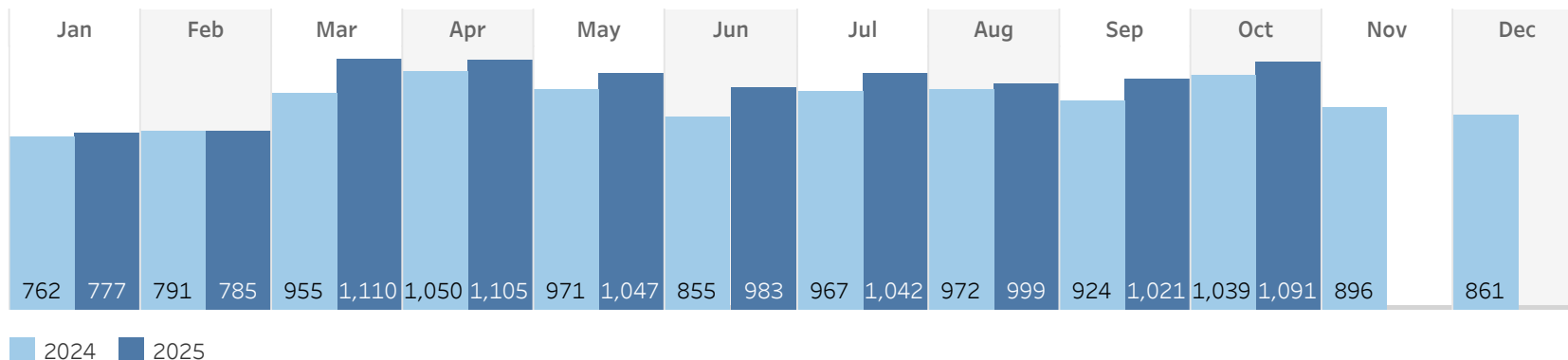

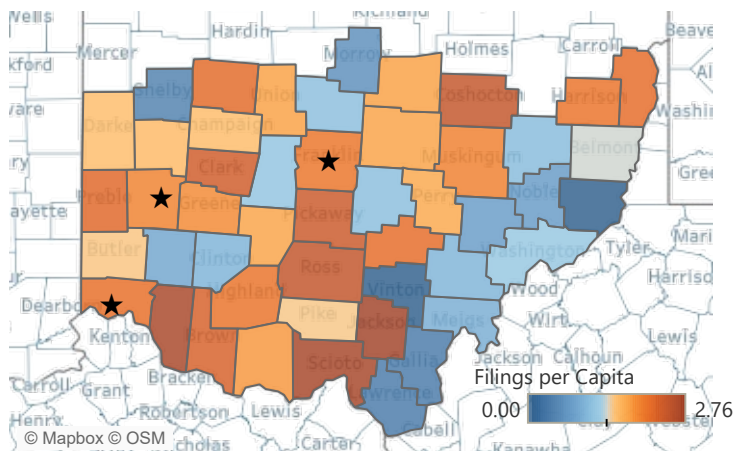

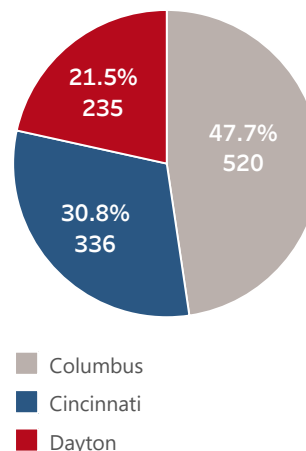
## Per Capita Filings
