The Court hereby establishes an Attorney Advisory Committee (the "Committee") to: (1) assist the Court and the Clerk's Office in the identification of practices and procedures for the purpose of reducing expense and delay in the administration of justice; (2) assist the Court and the Clerk's Office with the implementation of various projects that impact the bankruptcy bar; (3) serve as a resource for attorneys who practice in this District; and (4) serve as a group dedicated to enhancing communication between the various stakeholders in the practice of bankruptcy law in this District.

The Chief Judge shall appoint all members of the Committee, which shall include the Chief Deputy, an operations subject matter expert from the Clerk's Office, and one or more attorney members from each court location. The Chief Judge may appoint a chair, alter the size of the Committee, and remove members who do not regularly attend scheduled meetings of the Committee. The term of service for each attorney member shall be two or three years as specified by the Chief Judge. Terms will run from August 15 of the year of appointment.

The Committee shall meet as frequently as needed, but at least quarterly. The Committee and its subcommittees are encouraged to use the Court's video conference facilities for meetings.
